Council Tax Scam

Royal Greenwich Trading Standards have been made aware of a Council Tax scam sent via text message stating you are due a council tax refund. It requests that you go to; https://www.thecounciltax.com this is not a genuine gov.uk website and you should contact your local authority direct if you think you have overpaid your council tax.

Whether you receive a text message, phone call or email:

- Never give any private information away (such as bank details or date of birth).
- If you're concerned you've been scammed, get in touch with your bank to inform them **immediately**.
- You can also call your phone provider to see if the call was genuine.
- You would never receive a call regarding tax or tax credit in this way.
- If you have any doubt, ensure you contact the local council before proceeding.

If you have been a victim of a scam please report it to Action Fraud using the details below.

BLOCKING NUISANCE CALLS

The Telephone Preference Service (TPS) is a <u>FREE</u> service. It is the official central opt out register on which you can record your preference not to receive unsolicited sales or marketing calls.
