New Safeguarding Adults Forms- We redesigned the safeguarding adult's forms to ensure they reflect the desired outcomes of the adult at risk.



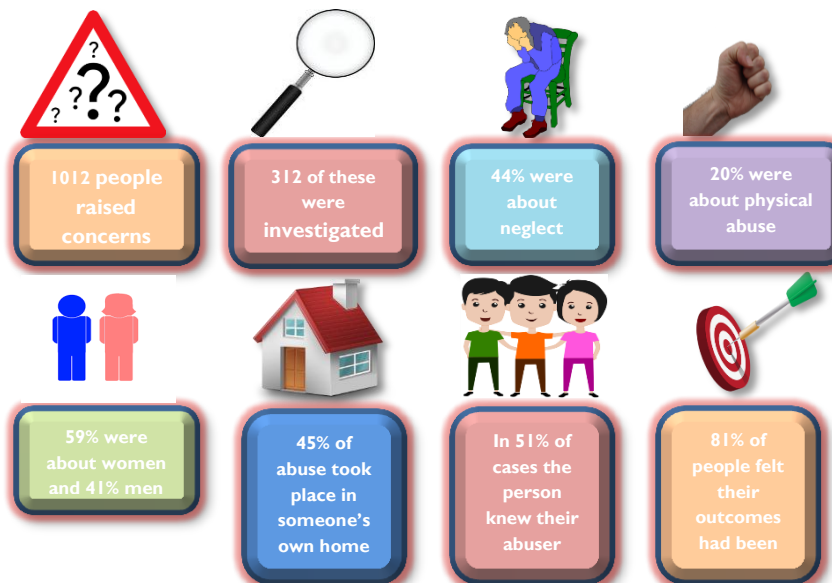
London Fire Brigade trained 5 home care providers' around the risks of fire. Each session was attended by between **6-20** staff.
